New Online Meal Payment System Available

We have an exciting new option to help make your life easier. MySchoolBucks.com is an online system that will allow you to make deposits into your student's school meal accounts, view account balances, create payment reminders and review purchase history, all in one secure online location.

MySchoolBucks offers...

- Safety: Virtually eliminates worries about your child carrying money to school.
- Convenience: Make payments when it's convenient for you, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week!
- Control:
- Receive low balance email reminders (set your own limits!)
- Monitor your student's account balances online.
- View your student's cafeteria purchases.
- **Efficiency**: Make your payments for all your children in one easy step, even if they attend different schools in the district.
- Flexibility:
- Make payments using your VISA, Master Card, Discover credit/debit cards or electronic check.
- Option to have payments made automatically each month.
- Deposit confirmations sent directly to your email account.

Getting Started Is Easy!

To create an account, simply go to www.myschoolbucks.com and register using the "Start Here" link on the right side of the page. A confirmation e-mail will be sent to the e-mail address you provide. Click the link included in the e-mail and your registration will be complete. Once you log in, you can add as many students to your account as you'd like by entering each student's school, their name, and date of birth. MySchoolBucks allows you to check balances, review transaction history, and receive low balance alerts from the comfort of your home for no charge. In order to use the online prepayment service, a small convenience fee for each transaction will be assessed to cover the bank fees. The convenience fee is \$2.50 per deposit transaction. Parents placing money into multiple meal accounts will only be assessed the \$2.50 fee once per deposit transaction. Charlotte County Public Schools does not profit from the use of this site.
